New ICT Resources

I'm pleased to inform our community of recent upgrades to our ICT resources. Our fleet of 52 netbooks for use in Grade 3-6 has been replaced, and we have also built up our number of I-pads for students to 100. When combined with our desktops our ratio of ICT equipment per student is nearing 1:2 and offers exceptional access for students. New multi-function device printers were also delivered this week, so that all students have access to colour printing. Finally, we have also purchased 4 brand new state of the art Interactive Whiteboards that will be installed in the Senior Learning Centre soon. These new IWBs work like a giant I-pad and the colour and clarity is truly impressive, making it a highly engaging tool to use with students. It's great to be able to provide these resources to support student learning.

We are looking forward to Education Week which commences on Monday 21st May and promises to be an exciting celebration of State Education at Amsleigh Park PS. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF will be provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students.


