With the Tutoring program recently announced we are currently working through the process to appoint a teacher to this role for 2021. This pivotal role will provide extended and intensive learning support to students who need some learning catch up after 2020. The successful person will work with students in small groups to provide differentiated learning for our students. The Department of Education and Training has made 2021 a year of catch up after 2020 was so disrupted, and we are confident that we can achieve this using the valuable resources we have been provided.

We will undertake a final farewell for our Grade 6 students on Thursday 17th December at 2.00pm. Class Structure for 2021

With moderate enrolment growth in 2020 we are moving from 14 to 15 classes in 2021. As a result our students can once again look forward to great class sizes between 20-25 students for Grade 1-6. We also have 3 Prep classes with 53 Preps enrolled for 2021.

We have been hard at work on allocating students to classes in recent weeks, and we will communicate this to all families on Tuesday 15th December. Our classes are finely tuned to balance out many factors including size, gender, academic ability, behaviour, participation, friendship and needs. We look for effective working relationships above friendship to ensure that learning is not hampered by distractions, but all students are guaranteed to have a person from their preference list.

Free Kindergarten in 2021

The Victorian Government recently announced that kinder programs for 3 and 4 year olds will be free in 2021. This could be a significant saving for many families, as Kindergarten can cost as much as \$2000 per annum to attend. The funding will be provided directly to kindergartens, and hopefully will lead to more children attending for this vital experience before coming to primary school.

End of Year Assembly – Thursday 17th December

We will be holding a special end of year assembly on Thursday 17th December at 9.00am. This will be an outdoor event at which we are intending to farewell the staff who are leaving us in 2020 and present the Student awards for 2020.

Ga-Ga Pit

Just in case you have been wondering what a 'GaGa Pit is here's a photo of the Amseigh Park PS Ga-Ga Zone nearing completion.

Ga Ga is a game similar to poison ball. Players tap the ball with their hands trying to get the ball to touch other players. If the ball touches you then you are out and you exit the arena. The winner is the last person left in the arena, and then the fun starts all over again.

This game is a huge hit with students, and the construction of our Ga Ga Pit is a great example of student voice and agency. It was the students who advocated for this project, and we are pleased to meet this request. Funding for our Ga Ga Pit was provided through a Federal Government Grant of \$5000.



Class Transition for 2021

All classes started our transition program for 2021 today, and will undertake three sessions to prepare for next year. Our transition program helps to reduce any anxiety in the process of moving up a grade level by demystifying many of the ideas that students have about this change. It's normal for students to worry about how they will cope and we aim to reassure them that all will be OK. During transition our students are introduced to the various learning opportunities that happen at the different year levels, and it often results in building excitement.


