From the Principal Team Changes to Drop Off and Pick Up at School

From Monday 22nd November the current drop-off and pick up procedures will change. From this date parents will be able to walk children back into our campus once again. We are very pleased to be able to welcome parents and carers onto our school grounds and look forward to this change of routine.

Currently parents or carers are not able to enter our school buildings. The only exception to this is if you have an appointment with the teacher. This will be in the place for the rest of the school year. The Department of Education have also instructed that any adult who enters our buildings must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. This vaccination requirement also applies to the general school office, and adults should make sure they sign in using the QR code if you need to come into this area.



Thanks for your ongoing patience as we continue to manage our school in a COVID safe way. We always try and apply a common-sense approach, focusing on the safety of our students and staff.

Class Structure 2022

Planning a fair and equitable class structure for 2022 is underway. Through this process we must decide on the number of classes required at each level, so we can provide an optimal learning environment for all. There are several considerations we must make when planning our class structure which include:

- Government funding All schools are funded for the number of students enrolled and we need to staff both classroom and specialist programs
- The number of students in each year level e.g. We have 50 Grade 6s in 2022
- Class size and equity for all
- Organisation of the Curriculum

Of course, the key factor in all schools will always be quality teaching, so whilst the grade structure is important, we know that it is not as important as the work our teachers do every day.

Nude Food Days

The Enviro-stars would like to challenge us to increase our commitment to nude food. We have noticed that many Amsleigh Park PS students bring food to school that has lots of plastic packaging, and as a result we have lots of waste. Ideally, it would be better if we did not have to dispose of so much of this kind of waste, which goes directly to landfill.

We understand that this is not always that easy to organise, but every little bit helps. From now on the Enviro-stars are encouraging us to bring nude food on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The Enviro-stars class rep will count how many students bring nude food so we can track how we are going.

COVID Safe Use of School Facilities

We have several groups who use the Amsleigh Park PS facilities out of hours, and I want to reassure our families that this is done following a COVID safety plan. All users must adhere to this by making sure that spaces are cleaned and sanitised after use. Only students and teachers involved in these programs can enter buildings. Amsleigh Park has partnerships with organisations including Aurora Calisthenics, Spectrum Tuition and Omiros Greek Language School. All our outside users are respectful of our facilities and value working in partnership with us.

Shade Sail Grant

I'm very pleased to report we are the recipient of another Shade Grant from the Department of Education and Training to the value of \$25000. This will enable our school to further increase shaded areas for our students to play and undertake learning outside. We will be seeking quotes to get this new sail installed as soon as possible.

No 'nuts' at Amsleigh park PS

Amsleigh Park PS has a number of students who have serious nut allergies requiring the use of an epi-pen if experiencing a reaction. For this reason, we would like to remind everyone not to pack nuts or nut-based products for students to eat at school. This includes peanut butter and Muesli bars that contain nuts. Students can look forward to enjoying these foods at home. We greatly appreciate if families can support us to maintain a safe environment by ensuring they do not send such foods to school.

The last day for students in 2021 will be **<u>Thursday 16th December</u>**. School will finish a little earlier on this day concluding at 2.30pm. We are intending to do our traditional farewell for our Grade 6s on this day at 2.00pm. Friday 17th December is a Student Free Day. End of Year Activities

Working within the various COVID restrictions we are planning to undertake as many of our usual end of year activities in a modified format. So, for example, we'll still be running elections for Student Leaders for 2022 and announcing them in December. Our Grade 6s will still have a modified Graduation ceremony and can look forward to attending their Year 7 orientation day on Tuesday 7th December. All students will participate in our all-important whole school transition program, preparing them to move onto the next year level.

Prep Orientation Next Week

We are looking forward to welcoming our 53 new preps for 2022 next Wednesday 24th November. We have organised 3 sessions across the Morning, with the children attending one session. We will be holding four transition sessions in total, one each Wednesday until the end of the year. It's an exciting time for our school to welcome lots of new families. Family Account Information

Credit Notes for 2021 cancelled Camps and Excursions/Incursions have now been processed. A reminder to please settle any outstanding fees as soon as possible. Let us know if you would like credit notes allocated to outstanding charges and also if you have made a BPay payment by sending an email to <u>amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au</u> to advise us which fees are being paid so the correct receipt allocations can be made. Please carefully check if you have a credit note/unallocated receipt amount on your family account that could be used to offset any outstanding fees and adjust your payment accordingly to avoid further overpayments. If you would like a refund of unallocated receipts/credit notes by EFT, please email the office for a Refund Request Form.

BPay is the preferred method of payment, followed by credit/debit card. If you have any queries regarding your family account, please contact the office.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (eg. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office. We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor. This does not include occasional antibiotics. Wherever possible, parents should request antibiotic prescriptions that can be taken at home, ie Antibiotics that are required 3 times per day can be taken at home in the morning, on return from school and again at bedtime. For students that do require antibiotics at school, a parent must complete a medication authority form when handing medication into the office. It is recommended that students with hayfever etc. take their medication at home before school. All medication must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students.

Absences / Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported to the General Office. Admin staff process all attendance data, including late arrivals and early exits. Teachers are notified of the absence/late arrival during this process. Absences can be advised using Xuno, email or phoning the school and selecting "1" when prompted to leave an absence message. **Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.** Parents should complete the sign in register, fill out a "Late Slip" and hand this to their child who will proceed on their own to their classroom and give the late slip to the teacher.

Contacting The School

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address. Several emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with many other daily external emails. Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner. When responding to a teacher's email, refer to their email address that appears within their message and copy & paste this address into the address field.
