SESSION ONE - WEDNESDAY 15TH NOVEMBER 2023, 9:15AM-10:30AM

While the children are enjoying a classroom learning experience and an opportunity to engage in their first specialist session, all parents are invited to attend an information session with the Principal. Topics discussed include: school starting procedures and requirements, uniforms, booklists and general information regarding the school programs and support services. This important session will help assist you as a parent to be well prepared to support your child as they embark upon their first year at school.

SESSION TWO- WEDNESDAY 22ND NOVEMBER 2023, 9:15AM-10:30AM

Students will engage in another classroom learning experience and their second specialist session. At this time carers are invited to attend an information session with our Assistant Principal who will explain our Literacy Program and provide strategies for how you can help your child at home. Our Assistant Principal will also provide information about our student wellbeing and personal development programs.

SESSION THREE- WEDNESDAY 29TH NOVEMBER 2023, 9:15AM-10:30AM

During this session your child will engage in a classroom experience as well as their final specialist session. There will be no parent information session.

Parents are encouraged to leave their child for this session.

SESSION FOUR - WEDNESDAY 6TH DECEMBER 2023, 9:15AM-10:30AM

During this session, children will have the opportunity to meet their Grade 6 buddy. Every Prep student is matched to a Grade 6 student as part of our 'Better Buddies' Program aimed at providing individual support and friendship. The children will enjoy a STEM (Science-Technology- Engineering-Mathematics) activity where they will have time to work together with their buddy.

Parents are encouraged to leave their child for this session.

SESSION FIVE - TUESDAY 12TH DECEMBER 2023, 9:15AM-10:30AM

This final session is part of our whole school transition program known as 'Smart Start'. Students will spend one hour in their classroom with their 2024 teacher. Students will participate in some 'getting to know you' activities with their new classmates and teacher. Students will have a 'Fruit Break,' so we ask you to please bring a fruit snack for your child to eat at school.
