## Principal Team Report

### Farewell Jackie

Our ever smiling and helpful Administration Assistant, Jackie, has accepted a position at a school that takes her closer to home. We are all very sad to see Jackie leave APPS, but it's understandable that having a shorter commute to work is a good option.

Jackie has been one of the welcoming faces of Amsleigh Park over the past 5 years working initially on a Friday before taking on a 3-day role. Jackie brings warmth and kindness to our office and is wonderful when interacting with children who come up to the office. Her care and concern has always been appreciated.

On behalf of everyone at APPS I want to sincerely thank Jackie for her ongoing contribution to Amsleigh Park PS. We wish Jackie every happiness in her new role at Mordialloc College who are lucky to have you.



### Safety Week

Each term in week 5 we have a special week where safety is in focus, at which time we further build awareness or consolidate understandings of our safety practices. During our recent safety week, we undertook an evacuation drill to ensure that all students know exactly what to do in the unlikely event that we need to exit our buildings. We have three different kinds of safety actions that include evacuation, shelter in place, or lock down, each having a different purpose. These actions are all well understood by our staff and whilst we hope to never need to do this for 'real' we must always be prepared. Another focus during safety week is the Child Safety Standards. In Victoria we have 11 Child Safety standards designed to address child abuse. All schools must demonstrate how they meet the standards as part of their registration as a school. There are numerous aspects to child safety, but one important example is developing personal safety. In responding to child safety our students are taught about the 3Rs which is to recognise, react and report any situation where they are not feeling comfortable. ### SRC Toasty Time

Our SRC have been very busy lately and I commend them for their work at Amsleigh Park PS. This elected student body brings their ideas and interests to the group and translates them into actions that help our students. They also support and build awareness about other worthwhile causes such as the recent focus on indigenous literacy through the 'APPS Book Swap.' Student voice is important to our school as we seek ways to empower children and build their confidence to promote change.

The SRC have organised for the 'Cheer Cheese' Toasty Truck to visit APPS on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September as a fun event for our students. Children will be able to order a special cheese toasty for a lunch treat that day. The order form was distributed this week and all toasties must be ordered in advance, so the right amount of bread and cheese is ordered. Some of the sale proceeds will go back to the SRC to spend to the advantage of students.

## Community Working Bee

A big shout out of thanks to the Amsleigh Park PS community who came along to support our recent working bee. On that day the team topped up the mulch in our 3-6 playgrounds, cleaned up garden beds, did edges around our lawns, swept around playgrounds and collected litter. We greatly appreciate the ongoing support of our school community in keeping our grounds in order. A big thank-you to the Rana family who have a Baker's Delight store, for generously donating the bread for the sausage sizzle.



## New Soccer Goals and Post Pads

I'm pleased to report that we have another set of soccer goals on the school oval, and it could not have come at a more timely moment. Our students love their soccer, and the success of the Matildas is taking it up to another level of popularity. We are so fortunate to have an oval that allows for multiple games at once. You might also notice that some post pads have been installed on some of the support posts for the covered walkway. These post pads are designed to eliminate a tripping hazard caused by the storm water connections and their bright yellow colour making it easy to see.

## Prep becomes Foundation in 2024

The Department of Education now refers to the first year of school as 'Foundation' rather than the traditional prep, so from 2024 we will also refer to these classes by their new title. The new title places emphasis on the importance of establishing a strong foundation for learning in the first year of school. We are very encouraged by our prep enrolments for 2024 and now have more than 50 students who will be joining our Foundation Classes at Amsleigh Park PS. If any families have not enrolled yet we would appreciate it if you could do so as soon as possible. This number of foundation students take us back to 3 classes in 2024.

## Planning for 2024

Planning for a new school year starts in Term 3 when schools are asked to estimate their numbers for the following year. Looking into the crystal ball can be tricky as we do not know if any families are planning a move of house etc. In early Term 4 we will do our annual enrolment census, but it would be helpful in knowing of any potential changes as early as possible. If any families have already planned a move for 2024, can you please contact the General office on 9544 1553. Even if it's a possibility it would help to know this in advance. Rest assured it would not impact enrolment in any way, it's just better when planning that we have the most accurate information possible.

## Managing Student Illness

As a school we want to maintain a healthy environment for all students and staff. This is an extra challenge in the colder months of the Melbourne winter when most of us would 'catch a cold or flu' at some point. As we tend to spend more time indoors during this time there is a higher rate of illness across the school. When children then attend school infected with a cold/Flu/COVID virus it is often easily transmitted to other students, often leading to an outbreak affecting a whole class and their families. The only way to minimise this is if children stay home until they are not infectious. As hard as this is for working parents, we do need you to support our efforts, and keep children home to recover enough so they are no longer highly infectious. We also continue to put hand washing practices in place and encourage other good hygiene habits such as coughing and sneezing into an elbow and sanitising hands after blowing your nose.

## Defibrillator

Did you know that we have a St John's Defibrillator. This is located just outside the First Aid room doorway. We hope that we never have to use this, however, it is very reassuring to know that we have it available if any member of our school or local community requires this.

### DEFIBRILLATORS SAVE LIVES

Why you need a Defibrillator during a sudden cardiac arrest:

- Defibrillation within the first few minutes of having a Sudden Cardiac Arrest increases the chance of survival to over 70%
- Without early defibrillation with an AED, less than 5% of cardiac arrest victims survive
- Without defibrillation, for every minute that passes, the chance of survival reduces by 10%
- Average Victorian ambulance response times are approximately 8-10 minutes in metro areas and up to 30 minutes in regional areas – defibrillation in combination with CPR gives victims the best chance of survival when waiting for Ambulance to arrive.



## NCCD 2023 - Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability

Every year, all schools in Australia participate in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The NCCD process requires schools to identify information already available in the school about supports provided to students with disability. These relate to legislative requirements under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 and the Disability Standards for Education 2005, in line with the NCCD guidelines (2019).

Information provided about students to the Australian Government for the NCCD includes:

- year of schooling
- category of disability: physical, cognitive, sensory or social/emotional
- level of adjustment provided: support provided within quality differentiated teaching practice, supplementary, substantial or extensive.

The NCCD provides state and federal governments with the information they need to plan more broadly for the support of students with disability.

The NCCD has no direct impact on your child and your child will not be involved in any testing process. The school will provide data to the Australian Government in such a way that no individual student will be able to be identified – the privacy and confidentiality of all students is ensured. All information is protected by privacy laws that regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information.

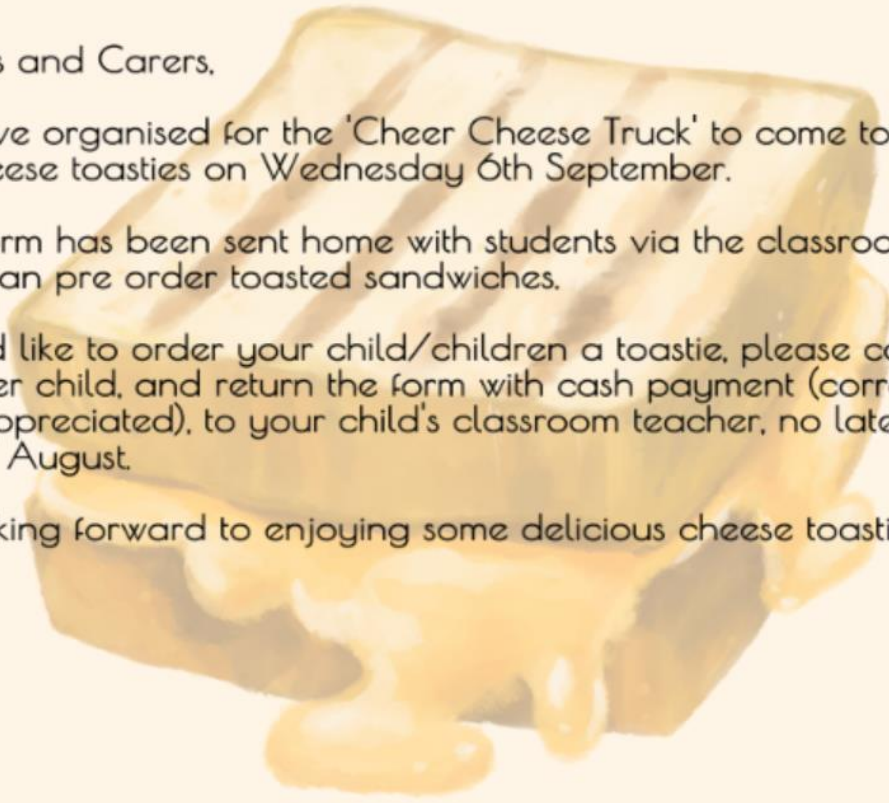
The SRC have organised for the 'Cheer Cheese Truck' to come to school and sell cheese toasties on Wednesday 6th September.

## FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE ADMIN TEAM.....

### Family Account Information

Thanks to the families that have paid 2023 Parent Contributions.

Please ensure that a **completed Payment Advice Form is sent to the office** so invoices can be processed, and payments allocated correctly.

### Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (eg. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office. **We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.** Parents are required to provide up to date Action Plans and inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

This does not however, include occasional antibiotics. Wherever possible, parents should request antibiotic prescriptions that can be taken at home, ie Antibiotics that are required 3 times per day can be taken at home in the morning, on return from school and again at bedtime. For students that do require antibiotics at school, a parent must complete a medication authority form when handing medication into the office. All medication must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students.

It is recommended that students with hayfever etc. take their medication at home before school.

### Absences / Late Arrivals

**A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno.** This ensures that Admin staff, who process all attendance data, including late arrivals and early exits are receiving the information in the first instance. Teachers are notified of the absence/late arrival during this process. If you wish to pass on any further information to teachers, please send them an additional email. If unable to report via Xuno, absences can be advised by emailing the General Office or phoning the school and selecting "1" when prompted to leave an absence message. **Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.** Parents should complete the sign in register, fill out a "Late Slip" and hand this to their child who will proceed on their own to their classroom and give the late slip to the teacher.

### School Emails – Check the email address you are sending / replying to

When contacting classroom teachers, or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the **'To'** address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails. Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

When responding to a teacher's email, please refer to their email address that appears within their message and copy & paste that address into the address field.

## Information for families

Since the beginning of 2021, Amsleigh Park commenced using Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, permission forms and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno. Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email, to create a Xuno account and password in your browser.
