## Principal Team Report

### Welcome Back for Term 3

A warm welcome back to all members of the Amsleigh Park Primary School community for Term 3. I trust that everyone enjoyed a great break away from the rigours of school life. It was a little chilly, but I hope every got rugged up and headed out for some fresh air.

In Term 3 I always talk about it as the 'hardworking term.' It's a term of consolidation in which our students can make increased gains in their learning and use the improvement areas from their mid-year report to set challenging learning goals. Our students should start to accelerate in their learning by focusing their efforts every day at school. Parents can support this endeavour by checking in with their child/ren as the term progresses and reinforcing the need to do their best every day and persevere when challenged.

### Smile Squad hits 100 000

Amsleigh Park PS played host to three Victorian Government Ministers this week who were here to celebrate Smile Squad reaching the milestone of seeing 100 000 students. Along with several other dignitaries who work in this great program, Minister for Health, Hon. Mary Anne Thomas, Minister for Children, Hon. Lizzie Blandthorn and local member and Minister for Events, Hon. Steve Dimopoulos visited to acknowledge this marvellous achievement. Four very excited Grade 2s, Ethan, Elisa, Luca and Richard, got to play host to our visitors and were excited to show off how the Smile Squad van works. It's a very impressive set up and I was interested to hear that there are another 50 of the exact same vans out there providing FREE dental health care for Victorian primary school children. With a large media presence this event generated a lot of excitement across the school.

Amsleigh Park is grateful to host the Smile Squad and around 50% of our students take up this option annually. Over the longer term this program will

mean that children have healthier teeth and are less likely to need expensive dental treatment. The smile squad also provide free toothbrushes and toothpaste prior to their visit just to make sure children have access to the right items needed for good dental hygiene. Thanks to our Grade 2s who did a great job as our Smile Squad ambassadors.



### Our New Grade 2 Picnic Area

Our Parents and Friends Association have funded a new picnic area outside our Grade 2 classrooms. This project was completed in the school holidays and the artificial grass surface and new aluminium picnic tables look great. We really appreciate that we were able to use locally raised funds from our school community to improve this area and big thanks to the PFA who do most of the fund raising. ## Mid-Year Reports

Student Reports were distributed in Term 2 and offer parents and carers a great chance to celebrate the achievements and progress their child/ren made at school so far in 2024. I enjoyed reading the wonderful general comments from class teachers, and I appreciate how personalised our reports are. It is important to celebrate each child's progress at school, which helps to build their self-esteem and learning confidence.

## NAPLAN 2023

The results of NAPLAN testing for 2024 came out this week and we are pleased to see that our students in Grades 3 & 5 were successful. One standout area is Reading, and our results were very high again this year. Given we have put a lot of effort into the teaching of Reading over the past few years this result is very pleasing for our staff and students.

The proficiency standards for NAPLAN are as follows:

- **Exceeding:** the student's result exceeds expectations at the time of testing.
- **Strong:** the student's result meets challenging but reasonable expectations at the time of testing.
- **Developing:** the student's result indicates that they are working towards expectations at the time of testing.
- **Needs additional support:** the student's result indicates that they are not achieving the learning outcomes expected at the time of testing. They are likely to need additional support to progress satisfactorily. It will be the clear responsibility of schools to ensure these students are provided with the additional support needed to progress satisfactorily, informed by NAPLAN results, other school-based assessment data and teachers' knowledge of these students.

Students' NAPLAN reports will continue to show how they are tracking in comparison to their peers and provide an indication of their skill levels against national averages and where we would expect them to be in order to get the most out of schooling. This provides valuable information to teachers about how we can continue to support your child.

Each set of NAPLAN results is an important milestone but it's also important that students know that one result does not define them – these results are about making sure every student gets the support they need so they can continue to get the best from their learning. Copies of student results will be sent home to parents shortly. Please retain this report for future reference as the school does not have copies on file.

## Premiers' Reading Challenge 2024

There are now about 50 days to go in the PRC for this year so keep reading and logging your books. We look forward to seeing how many students complete this challenge for 2024.

## Muddy Clothes

We noticed this week that with very wet conditions across our school grounds a good number of students ended up very muddy after playing soccer and other games on the grass. It's very uncomfortable to be in wet clothing and bringing dirty muddy clothes into classrooms also means that our freshly spring-cleaned classrooms end up in a mess. We will ask students to be more careful in their play, but this does not mean that accidents won't happen, so if families could pop a spare pair of trackpants into their child's bag it would help. This would be very important if you know your child is often coming home in muddy clothes.

There is a lot to look forward to across Term 3 with our annual School Production high on our list of exciting learning opportunities. The production for 2024 is 'The Olympic Heist' will be performed on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2024 at Salesian College. As in past years we run a very tight production schedule so that this event does not interfere with other learning programs. Students start learning songs in Week 3 and progress from there. A call for volunteers will go out shortly and we appreciate all the help we can get with this big event.

## FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE ADMIN TEAM.....

### Family Account Information

### Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (eg. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

**We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.**

Parents are required to provide up to date Action Plans and inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

This does not however, include occasional antibiotics. Wherever possible, parents should request antibiotic prescriptions that can be taken at home, ie Antibiotics that are required 3 times per day can be taken at home in the morning, on return from school and again at bedtime. For students that do require antibiotics at school, a parent must complete a medication authority form when handing medication into the office.

**All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students.**

It is recommended that students with hayfever etc. take their medication at home before school.

### Absences / Late Arrivals

**A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno.** This ensures that Admin staff, who process all attendance data, including late arrivals and early exits, are receiving the attendance information in the first instance. Teachers are notified of the absence/late arrival during this process. If you wish to pass on any further information to teachers, please send them an additional email. If unable to report via Xuno, absences can also be advised by emailing the General Office or phoning the school and selecting "1" when prompted to leave an absence message.

**Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.**

Parents should complete the sign in register, fill out a "Late Slip" and hand this to their child who will proceed on their own to their classroom and give the late slip to the teacher.

### School Emails – Check the email address you are sending / replying to

When contacting classroom teachers, or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

When responding to a teacher's email, please refer to their email address that appears within their message and copy & paste that address into the address field.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.
