During the recent school holidays Miss Maley and her fiancé had a wonderful wedding ceremony on the banks of the Swan River in Perth. Intervention and Classroom Support

Over the past few years, we have had an increasing focus on learning intervention and support at APPS. Learning support is primarily provided by the classroom teacher who is responsible for providing targeted and ongoing assistance to students every day. However, sometimes there is a need for students to receive additional supports as well. These supports can come through various forms which include reading intervention in Grade 1, small group literacy support in F-2, Toe x Toe Literacy and the tutoring learning initiative. All are highly valuable resources and children are identified (using a range of data) based on those who have the greatest need. In addition to this there are also times when students might work in small group with a Teacher Aide who is working in a classroom. The latter is usually flexible and can vary depending on the learning focus of the day. If you have any questions about these supports, please contact Mr Cormick or Miss Carr.

School Library

Our Librarian Martin reopened our school Library this week and he reports that many students enjoyed the opportunity for a lunchtime visit. Doing some quiet reading or playing a board game with a friend were popular choices.

Anaphylaxis Reminder

At Amsleigh Park PS we currently have 9 students who are at risk of anaphylaxis (across a range of year levels) if exposed to certain allergens, with the most prevalent of these being peanuts and/or nut-based products. For this reason, we ask that no nuts, peanut butter, Nutella or similar be sent to school at any time. Anaphylaxis can be a serious life-threatening condition, and we need to take great care to ensure anyone effected can be safe at school. This illness is considered so serious that it is covered by Ministerial Order 706 which sets out very clear instructions for schools to follow.

In addition to not bringing nuts to school children should not share food at any time, because you never know if a cross contamination has occurred at home in the food preparation. We ask for the support of all families in the management of anaphylaxis.

XUNO

Thank-you to families who are subscribed and regular users of XUNO. This online tool/App is our main option for communicating with our school families. Most messages go out via XUNO mail and therefore will be sent to the email accounts of all subscribers. In many instances this means that a family might receive the email to both parent's email account. It is very important that the email account is active and checked regularly. Please note that we will not send urgent messages via XUNO, and we will always contact parents via phone in this instance.

Information regarding excursions and events is also available via XUNO and includes payment and electronic permission/approval. The permission/approval is a two-step process that includes a special SMS code. These events can be accessed from the XUNO dashboard, and it is a relatively easy process to complete. You will still have the option to pay with unallocated receipts, CSEF, SSB or credit notes from your family account, please contact the general office for assistance with processing these payment types.

School Promotion



Each year we conduct a range of promotional activities so that prospective families find out about our school. Being hidden away in Oakleigh East is great, but it also means that some families do not even know we are here, even after we have placed materials at all local pre-schools and childcare centres. One thing we do know is that 'word of mouth' is one of the best forms of promotion, and a positive word often brings families along for a look. If anyone asks, encourage them to come along for a tour, and they can see all the great things that are happening. If you are still involved in local pre-schools or childcare, please encourage other local families to visit Amsleigh Park for a tour.

CCTV

I want to inform our community, as a courtesy, that we have CCTV cameras all around Amsleigh Park PS. The purpose of these cameras is to provide security for our school campus out of school hours. CCTV is a very effective deterrent and helps us to ensure we are not subject to vandalism. The footage is kept for a period of two weeks and is only accessed if there is an issue.



Family Bush Dance – Save the Date

On Wednesday 5th March we are holding the Amsleigh Park School Community Bush Dance for 2025. We run this event every second year and for anyone new to APPS it's a wonderful night full of fun and a chance to connect with other members of the school community. The Bush Dance is being run between 5.00pm and 7.00pm and we encourage families to bring a picnic along. Our students will prepare for the bush dance the week before the event participating in a workshop at school to learn the dances. This event is a crowd favourite, and we hope to see you there.

New Shade Sails

I'm pleased to report that we have new shade sails over the 3-6 playground. After the previous set was seriously damaged in a storm in 2024, the sails have been redesigned to be more robust and long wearing. Given the current weather pattern this is quite timely. We have many shade options at school across our play areas so students can practise sun smart behaviours by using these areas.



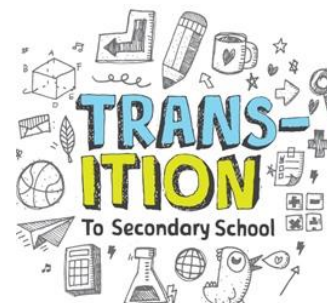
School Picnic

In the meantime, we encourage our senior students and their families to attend open days/night and tour Secondary Schools in the area to become familiar with the possible schools your child may attend. If interested, please contact your local Catholic or Independent Secondary Schools to inquire into their enrolment process, as they differ from the shared process of all Government Secondary Schools. School Wide Positive Behaviour Support ~ SWPBS

School Wide Positive Behaviour Support (SWPBS) is implemented at Amsleigh Park to improve the learning and wellbeing of all students. SWPBS is a whole school approach for creating a positive, safe and supportive school climate in which students can learn and develop.

All staff are responsible for teaching the behaviour expectations, providing consistent positive feedback to students, and delivering consistent corrective feedback. The entire school, including the learning areas, walkways, toilets and playgrounds are all considered part of the total learning environment.

We have included the behaviour matrix below, for new families to become familiar with. You will see that the matrix is based on our school values, with a breakdown of how people can show that value in different settings. Our students have been demonstrating many of the expected behaviours and have been acknowledged for their great choices in these areas.



Team Kids

We have been receiving a lot of positive feedback about our new out of school hours care program run by Team Kids. It's great to hear that students are enjoying the change in format, activities and routines. Along with offering our students a great program, Team Kids have very organised practices and pay very close attention to communicating well with families and ensuring all things have a process.

Regarding bookings and payments, we would encourage all families to be on top of this as Team Kids, like all the newer providers in the OSHC industry have clear policies. All bookings need to be cancelled with 48 hours' notice if children are not going to attend or a medical certificate provided if children are ill. This is standard practice as all providers need to organise staff in advance, based on the number of children booked in. As they incur costs these will be passed onto parents and carers. They provide great service, but it is also a business, and their policy is very clear on this.

FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE ADMIN TEAM...

Family Accounts

Please regularly check your Xuno account for any fees or events that require payment and or approval. A reminder that unallocated CSEF, receipts or credit notes from your family account can be used to pay for events. Credit note amounts are shown with a negative symbol, **-\$10.00**. If you would like a copy of your current account statement, please email the office.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor. Parents are required to provide up to date Action Plans and inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

This does not however, include occasional antibiotics. Wherever possible, parents should request antibiotic prescriptions that can be taken at home, ie Antibiotics that are required 3 times per day can be taken at home in the morning, on return from school and again at bedtime. For students that do require antibiotics at school, a parent must complete a medication authority form when handing medication into the office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students. It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences / Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno. This ensures that Admin staff, who process all attendance data, including late arrivals and early exits, are receiving the attendance information in the first instance. Teachers are notified of the absence/late arrival during this process. If you wish to pass on any further information to teachers, please send them an additional email. Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's Unexplained Absences in Xuno. Please regularly check your child's attendance data and update as required. If unable to report via Xuno, absences can also be advised by emailing the General Office or phoning the school and selecting "1" when prompted to leave an absence message.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

Parents should complete the sign in register, fill out a "Late Slip" and hand this to their child who will proceed on their own to their classroom and give the late slip to the teacher.

School Emails – Check the email address you are sending / replying to

When contacting classroom teachers, or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

When responding to a teacher's email, please refer to their email address that appears within their message and copy & paste that address into the address field.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS (SSB)

Families wishing to use their School Saving Bonus for camp, excursions/incursions, activities **must take the following steps:** -

1. Reallocate your School Saving Bonus from the default "Textbooks/Uniforms" in the School Saving Bonus portal to "School Activities" It is recommended that the whole \$400 is reallocated in one transaction by parents of students going to camp this year. This will decrease the number of processes required by parents and also Admin staff.
2. Email the school inbox (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) with the subject header "USE my SSB - Child's name & Grade – Activity name & total amount.

Example - USE my SSB – John Smith 6C – G5-6 Summer Sport \$24

We will cross check this with reports that flow through from the SSB Portal to us and then process this allocation manually on your behalf.

School Saving Bonus (SSB) Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Can I use the SSB to purchase stationary/book packs?**

No. The SSB cannot be used to purchase Book Packs/Book List Items. The Department of Education has included Textbooks only as allowable purchases using the SSB from authorised suppliers. Amsleigh Park PS students do not require any textbooks.

You will still need to order and pay for your book packs via Office Corporate as previously advised.

- **Do I need to allocate money to uniforms in the SSB Portal?**

No, because we have a school run onsite uniform shop. Parents will need to complete **a green SSB uniform order form** and submit it to the school office for all uniform items. Admin staff will process then forward the order to the uniform shop for picking and packing. Orders will be sent to the child's classroom unless alternative collection from the office or uniform shop is requested..

- **Will I need to put the voucher code into the portal to allocate the SSB to activities?**

Yes – For parents with students who will be attending camp in 2025, please allocate the whole amount of the SSB (\$400) in one transaction to "School Activities"

- **Do I need to tell the school when I want to use the SSB for activities (i.e. camps, sports, excursions, incursions, swimming)?**

Yes. Each time you wish to use the SSB for payment of a school activity, you will need to advise the school via email (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) to let us know which activity you wish to use this SSB money for. See information above regarding the subject header.

- **Can I take uniforms on the day if I want to use the SSB?**

No. You will need to submit a green SSB uniform order form to be processed via the office. We will then supply the uniforms to your child's classroom to take home.

- **Does the SSB money expire if I don't use it all in 2025?**

No. The money will carry over to the following year

- **Is the SSB only able to be used for each individual sibling?**

No. The SSB is allocated to the family and can be used for any student in the immediate family

- **Can I only use the SSB on uniform purchases before June 30, 2025?**

Yes. After June 30, 2025 the SSB money will automatically be allocated to school activities.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year **unless there has been a change in your family circumstances**.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

- Some children's crossings have a supervisor - always follow their instructions
- If there is no supervisor, look and listen for traffic before crossing
- Only cross the road when safe to do so, and keep looking and listening while crossing.

IF YOU'RE A DRIVER/RIDER:

- Always watch out for children near schools
- Do not overtake a vehicle stopping/stopped at a crossing
- Stop if someone is about to cross or is crossing - even if there is no supervisor
- Stop if a hand-held 'Stop' sign is displayed
- Only proceed when all pedestrians, including the supervisor, are clear of the crossing
- Approach the crossing at a speed slow enough to stop safely if needed
- Always be aware of all parking signage and park legally.

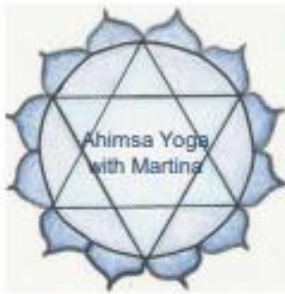
