I saw the parachute getting a good work out with Miss Hayes overseeing the fun whilst the adults had a chance to chat.



Many thanks to teachers from the F-2 team, Miss Carr and Miss Hayes who stayed behind on Tuesday to help serve the pizza. A shout out to Justin Scott who came along from the PFA to provide some insights into this important group and the crew from Team Kids who were on hand to answer questions about OSHC. Special thanks to Foundie teachers, Miss Barker and Mrs

Maisey for organising the event and thanks to everyone for coming along. We all love these events which are highlights of the school calendar.

School Council 2025

We had our first meeting for 2025 this week, which is in fact the final meeting of the council from 2024. Following a busy agenda the council continues the good work of providing governance and oversight to Amsleigh Park PS.

At our first meeting we allocated some of the funds we have set aside through PFA fundraising, bank interest and facility hire to some important projects including new shade sails for the F-2 playground, an addition to the play equipment for F-2 students, a creative play space for students, upgraded computers and i-pads for the STEM program and some library resources. We are well pleased to be delivering ongoing improvements to Amsleigh Park and the kids are always the beneficiaries.

PFA Annual General Meeting

Our wonderfully supportive Parents and Friends Association are getting busy for 2025. They have an AGM which is organised for Wednesday 26 February at 7pm in the shack. All are welcome.

We are highly indebted to the APPS PFA for their ongoing support of many events at our school. This partnership is vitally important and adds great value and richness to school life. The main aim of the PFA is to provide a chance for parents and carers to build connections at Amsleigh Park. Being active in the school is both a rewarding and enjoyable experience for many parents and carers. Along the way the PFA also raises some funds that are put to good use in improving the quality of resources, equipment and infrastructure. We are very fortunate to have many dedicated folks who support the PFA. Special shout out to President, Justin Scott and Secretary, Suzi Ikin for their ongoing efforts.

Assembly Changes

This week we sent out an email about changes to the frequency of school assemblies. The idea is to reduce the number of assemblies so we can use that time for learning. It might not seem like a big deal, but it is a session each week and over a year that's then more than 40 sessions, which is more than a week of school. The extra 20 sessions we gain can be devoted to learning. With such a busy curriculum program we need every moment possible. The next assembly will be on Friday 28 Feb and fortnightly on Friday's thereafter.

Extreme Weather Events

It was just over a year ago that we experienced an unprecedented weather event at Amsleigh Park in which the campus sustained damage to trees and playgrounds. Whilst we hope this was a once only event, this kind of thing does seem to be happening more often these days. After this storm in 2024 we reviewed the actions that contributed to community safety at this time and came up with the following action plan that we will follow in any similar emergency.

- In the case of extreme weather students will not be dismissed until it is safe to do so and will remain in classrooms as a shelter in place. This could mean students remain indoors after the dismissal bell.

- If any parents or carers find themselves in our school yard during an event such as this they should find shelter indoors. The foyer of the Thelma Bailey Centre, Library Foyer, General Office Foyer and JLC corridors are all places that parents and carers can shelter in place. You do not need to ask permission to shelter in place during an emergency.

- Do not shelter under trees in high winds or rain. We have several covered outdoor spaces such as the Sports Pavilion and covered walkway where you can seek safer shelter.

It might reassure you to know that we do regularly check the weather reports and have the Vic Emergency App set for notifications. We take a conservative approach to the weather, and we bring students indoors on days of extreme heat or wind.

Swimming Program 2025

Information about permission and payment for our annual Swimming Program has been distributed recently. The program will once again be held in the last two weeks of Term 1 at the Doug Ellis Pool at Monash University. It's an important opportunity for our students to develop their swimming and water safety skills. If you have already decided that your child will **not** be participating, please let us know by emailing the school at: amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au



Team Kids Important Information

If you are a regular user of the Teams Kids service please be aware of 'no show' costs of \$5.00. This is when a child is booked in and does not show up. The following is from team kids:

When a child is booked but does not attend without prior notification, our staff must undertake additional safety protocols, including:

- Contacting parents/guardians
- Communicating with the school
- Conducting a search of the school grounds
- Engaging emergency services if necessary.

These steps require significant time and resources, impacting our ability to provide the best possible care for all children. The No Show Fee helps ensure families remain accountable for timely cancellations, allowing our team to focus on supervising children who are present.

How Families Can Avoid the No Show Fee...

To avoid this charge, families must cancel bookings as follows:

- Before 2:00 PM on the day of care: Cancel online via their TeamKids account.
- After 2:00 PM on the day of care: Call the onsite team before the session starts to notify their child will not be in attendance.

Team kids provide a quality service but like all providers they do have clear policies for payments. It pays to stay on top of this in order to avoid having to pay any late fees. If a child is sick, then you can call the service directly and they will then know not to look for a student.

FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE ADMIN TEAM...

Family Accounts

Please regularly check your Xuno account for any fees or events that require payment and or approval. A reminder that unallocated CSEF, receipts or credit notes from your family account can be used to pay for events. Credit note amounts are shown with a negative symbol, **-\$10.00**. If you would like a copy of your current account statement, please email the office.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor. Parents are required to provide up to date Action Plans and inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

This does not however, include occasional antibiotics. Wherever possible, parents should request antibiotic prescriptions that can be taken at home, ie Antibiotics that are required 3 times per day can be taken at home in the morning, on return from school and again at bedtime. For students that do require antibiotics at school, a parent must complete a medication authority form when handing medication into the office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students. It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences / Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno. This ensures that Admin staff, who process all attendance data, including late arrivals and early exits, are receiving the attendance information in the first instance. Teachers are notified of the absence/late arrival during this process. If you wish to pass on any further information to teachers, please send them an additional email. Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's Unexplained Absences in Xuno. Please regularly check your child's attendance data and update as required. If unable to report via Xuno, absences can also be advised by emailing the General Office or phoning the school and selecting "1" when prompted to leave an absence message.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

Parents should complete the sign in register, fill out a "Late Slip" and hand this to their child who will proceed on their own to their classroom and give the late slip to the teacher.

School Emails – Check the email address you are sending / replying to

When contacting classroom teachers, or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

When responding to a teacher's email, please refer to their email address that appears within their message and copy & paste that address into the address field.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS (SSB)

Families wishing to use their School Saving Bonus for camp, excursions/incursions, activities **must take the following steps:** -

1. Reallocate your School Saving Bonus from the default "Textbooks/Uniforms" in the School Saving Bonus portal to "School Activities" It is recommended that the whole \$400 is reallocated in one transaction by parents of students going to camp this year. This will decrease the number of processes required by parents and also Admin staff.
2. Email the school inbox (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) with the subject header "USE my SSB - Child's name & Grade – Activity name & total amount.

Example - USE my SSB – John Smith 6C – G5-6 Summer Sport \$24

We will cross check this with reports that flow through from the SSB Portal to us and then process this allocation manually on your behalf.

School Saving Bonus (SSB) Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Can I use the SSB to purchase stationary/book packs?**

No. The SSB cannot be used to purchase Book Packs/Book List Items. The Department of Education has included Textbooks only as allowable purchases using the SSB from authorised suppliers. Amsleigh Park PS students do not require any textbooks.

- **Do I need to allocate money to uniforms in the SSB Portal?**

No, because we have a school run onsite uniform shop. Parents will need to complete **a Green SSB uniform order form** and submit it to the school office for all uniform items. Admin staff will process then forward the order to the uniform shop for picking and packing. Orders will be sent to the child's classroom unless alternative collection is requested.

- **Can I take uniforms on the day if I want to use the SSB?**

No. You will need to submit **a Green SSB uniform order form** to the office for processing by Admin Staff. Once processed the order will be given to the Uniform Shop. Orders may take a week, or longer to be filled depending on processing times, submission day of the order form and stock availability.

- **Can I only use the SSB on uniform purchases before June 30, 2025?**

Yes. After June 30, 2025, the SSB money will automatically be allocated to school activities.

- **Will I need to put the voucher code into the portal to re-allocate the SSB to activities?**

Yes – For parents with students who will be attending camp in 2025, please allocate the whole amount of the SSB (\$400) in one transaction to "School Activities"

- **Do I need to tell the school when I want to use the SSB for activities (i.e. camps, sports, excursions, incursions, swimming)?**

Yes. Each time you wish to use the SSB for payment of a school activity, you will need to advise the school via email (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) to let us know which activity you wish to use this SSB money for. See information above regarding the subject header. Approval will still be required for the event in the Xuno App.

- **Does the SSB money expire if I don't use it all in 2025?**

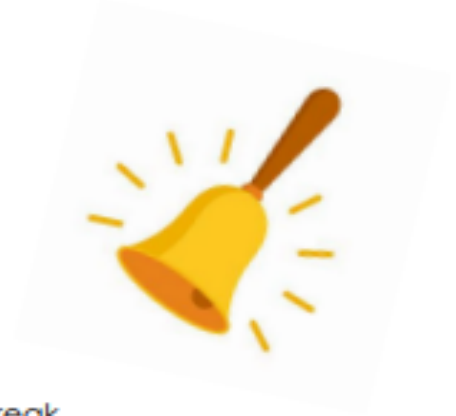
No. The money will carry over to the following year

- **Is the SSB only able to be used for each individual sibling?**

No. The SSB is allocated to the family and can be used for any student in the immediate family

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year **unless there has been a change in your family circumstances**.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

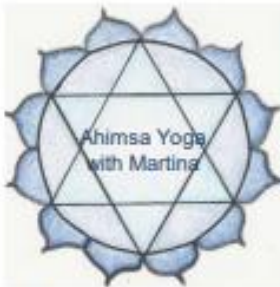
