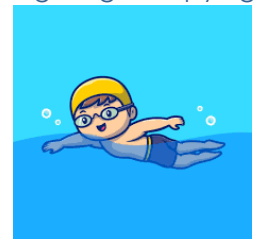
Swimming Program 2024

I hope that our students are looking forward to our swimming program which commences on Monday 24th March. This annual program is a great opportunity to further develop swimming skills and water safety knowledge. Given that Australians often enjoy water sports it is vital that all children learn to swim with proficiency.

Parents can attend the pool to observe sessions, but at no time should anyone interfere in the session or talk to instructors. In the unlikely event that anyone has a concern this should be raised with the classroom teacher or principal class team. We would also ask that no photos are taken at the pool, which infringes the rules of Centre and compromises student safety.

Please note that all helpers for swimming need to have a valid Working With Children Check card. This can be organised online and is a straightforward and FREE process for volunteers. If you are helping with swimming, please visit the office with your Working with Children Check Card for sighting & copying.

Some recent research highlighted that too many Australian Children are not reaching the required proficiency in swimming. The expectation is that a 12-year-old child should be able to swim 50m and float unassisted for 2 minutes. This is one of the reasons why our swimming program is so important. Thanks for supporting our students can meet this goal, it might just save their life one day.



Driver Beware – No Standing Zones Around APPS

We are hearing about quite a few parking fines from the City of Monash. One area that is a hot spot is on Dublin Street, just down from the school crossing. In this area you will find a **no standing sign**, and this means you cannot stop here to do a drop off. Even if you only stop for 30 seconds you will get booked and it is a \$200 fine. Traffic inspectors regularly patrol around schools, and we get no warning and have no influence in this regard. Some drivers incorrectly interpret this to mean no parking, whereas it means no standing (stopping) at any time or in the times specified on the sign. A reminder also that both staff car parks are for staff vehicles only at all times.



Kiss and Go Parking

We would like to remind everyone about 'Kiss and Go' parking rules. These zones are there so that parents and carers can do either a quick drop off or pick up. The driver must stay with the vehicle and be ready to move on if they are in the parking bay for more than a few minutes. Traffic inspectors regularly travel to school areas and will not hesitate to book drivers who leave their vehicles unattended or overstay in the car parking bays. Students who are being picked up after school should move quickly to the kiss and go parking bays so their parents or carers are not held up for too long.

Safety on our School Crossings

Having our school crossings on State Street and Dublin Street is vital in supporting us to maintain community safety. Our crossing supervisors have a very important role to play in assisting all families to arrive at school safely. We need to make sure that we support our crossing supervisors to undertake their role by following some simple and easy to understand rules:

- always use a crossing
- wait for the whistle before crossing
- always cross between the 2 white lines, remaining in front of the crossing supervisor



As we have a crossing on both Dublin Street and State Street, we discourage families from crossing the road within 100m of the crossing. Walking out from behind a parked car can be dangerous as drivers may not see you or your child. There have been some near misses in the past and we all need to be aware of this important safety thinking.

Walking Bikes in the School Yard

We want to remind everyone about walking Bikes in the school yard. It's great to see an increase in bike riding and we just need to make sure we do all we can to keep the yard a safe space for all. Our students are given regular reminders about this. Please keep in mind that the streets around the school are also very busy at pick up/drop off time and it might require students to walk bikes along State or Dublin Streets until there is a clear space to ride.

Illness

From time to time, children are unwell and are unavoidably absent from school. Although we would like students attending school every day where possible, it is important to keep sick children at home. This prevents other children becoming unwell and a bug spreading through the school. We have spoken to our students about the importance of hand washing and personal hygiene and appreciate your support in reinforcing this at home with your child.



School Uniform

We are very lucky at Amsleigh Park to have an onsite uniform shop, run by fantastic parent volunteers, lead by Lemo. Having parents undertake this role enables the school to continue to provide uniforms at a 'wholesale' price as our shop is non-profit. The uniform shop is open Wednesdays from 3:00-3:45pm. On the topic of uniforms, as we've visited classes this week we were pleased to see that our students were looking smart in their uniforms. A reminder that

our policy states that students should wear a light or dark coloured shoe, and this offers lots of scope in the design of shoe. Fluorescent shoes should not be worn as part of the school uniform, and we ask for community support to meet the school policy in this regard. It really does look fantastic when our whole school is in uniform. It creates a sense of connectedness and pride in our school.

Dreaming of a Career in F1

Grade 5 student, Jonathan, had a dream come true at the recent Australian F1 Gran Prix heading down into pit straight to see first-hand what it's like in the fast-paced world of motor racing. Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.

Parents are required to provide up to date Action Plans and inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students. It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to.

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the '**To**' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates

If you have any details that need to be updated – phone numbers, address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details

It will then let you update any of your details and it will notify us of any changes that have been made. This is an instant update.

CSEF – Do you have a healthcare/pension card?

Parents - If you currently hold a Centrelink health care or pension card **and did not claim CSEF through our school last year**, please come and see the office team and we can help you to apply for the CSEF payment. This is a \$154 per child payment to financially assist families with the cost of Camps, Sports Excursions, Swimming etc.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS (SSB)

Families wishing to use their School Saving Bonus for camp, excursions/incursions, activities must take the following steps: -

1. Reallocate your School Saving Bonus from the default "Textbooks/Uniforms" in the School Saving Bonus portal to "School Activities" It is recommended that the whole \$400 is reallocated in one transaction by parents of students going to camp this year. This will decrease the number of processes required by parents and also Admin staff.
2. Email the school inbox (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) with the subject header "USE my SSB - Child's name & Grade – Activity name & total amount.

Example - USE my SSB – John Smith 6C – G5-6 Summer Sport \$24

We will cross check this with reports that flow through from the SSB Portal to us and then process this allocation manually on your behalf.

School Saving Bonus (SSB) Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Can I use the SSB to purchase stationary/book packs?**

No. The SSB cannot be used to purchase Book Packs/Book List Items. The Department of Education has included Textbooks only as allowable purchases using the SSB from authorised suppliers. Amsleigh Park PS students do not require any textbooks.

- **Do I need to allocate money to uniforms in the SSB Portal?**

No, because we have a school run onsite uniform shop. Parents will need to complete **a Green SSB uniform order form** and submit it to the school office for all uniform items. Admin staff will process then forward the order to the uniform shop for picking and packing. Orders will be sent to the child's classroom unless alternative collection is requested.

- **Can I take uniforms on the day if I want to use the SSB?**

No. You will need to submit **a Green SSB uniform order form** to the office for processing by Admin Staff. Once processed the order will be given to the Uniform Shop. Orders may take a week, or longer to be filled depending on processing times, submission day of the order form and stock availability.

- **Can I only use the SSB on uniform purchases before June 30, 2025?**

Yes. After June 30, 2025, the SSB money will automatically be allocated to school activities.

- **Will I need to put the voucher code into the portal to re-allocate the SSB to activities?**

Yes – For parents with students who will be attending camp in 2025, please allocate the whole amount of the SSB (\$400) in one transaction to "School Activities"

- **Do I need to tell the school when I want to use the SSB for activities (i.e. camps, sports, excursions, incursions, swimming)?**

Yes. Each time you wish to use the SSB for payment of a school activity, you will need to advise the school via email (amsleigh.park.ps@education.vic.gov.au) to let us know which activity you wish to use this SSB money for. See information above regarding the subject header. Approval will still be required for the event in the Xuno App.

- **Does the SSB money expire if I don't use it all in 2025?**

No. The money will carry over to the following year

- **Is the SSB only able to be used for each individual sibling?**

No. The SSB is allocated to the family and can be used for any student in the immediate family

QUICK FACT SHEET

School Saving Bonus (SSB) Payments

Families wishing to use their SSB to pay for events **must take the following steps:**

1. Parent/Guardian must approve attendance/participation for offsite events in Xuno. (Incursions do not require approval/permission as the students are not leaving the school grounds)
2. Parent/Guardian to ensure the total cost of the event has been reallocated in the School Saving Bonus Parent Portal from the default allocation of "Textbooks/Uniforms" to "School Activities"
3. Parent/Guardian must email the General Office with the subject header "USE my SSB - Child's name & Grade - Activity Name and total amount

Example - USE my SSB – John Smith 6C – 5-6 Summer Sport \$24

We will cross check this with reports that flow through from the SSB Portal to us and then process this allocation manually on your behalf. Reallocations can take from 3-5 days to reach our system. Please ensure you have allowed for this processing time. Thank you.

In the event of incorrect sizing, please return unworn items/s with tags intact, together with the original packing slip that includes the child's name, grade and the correct size required.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

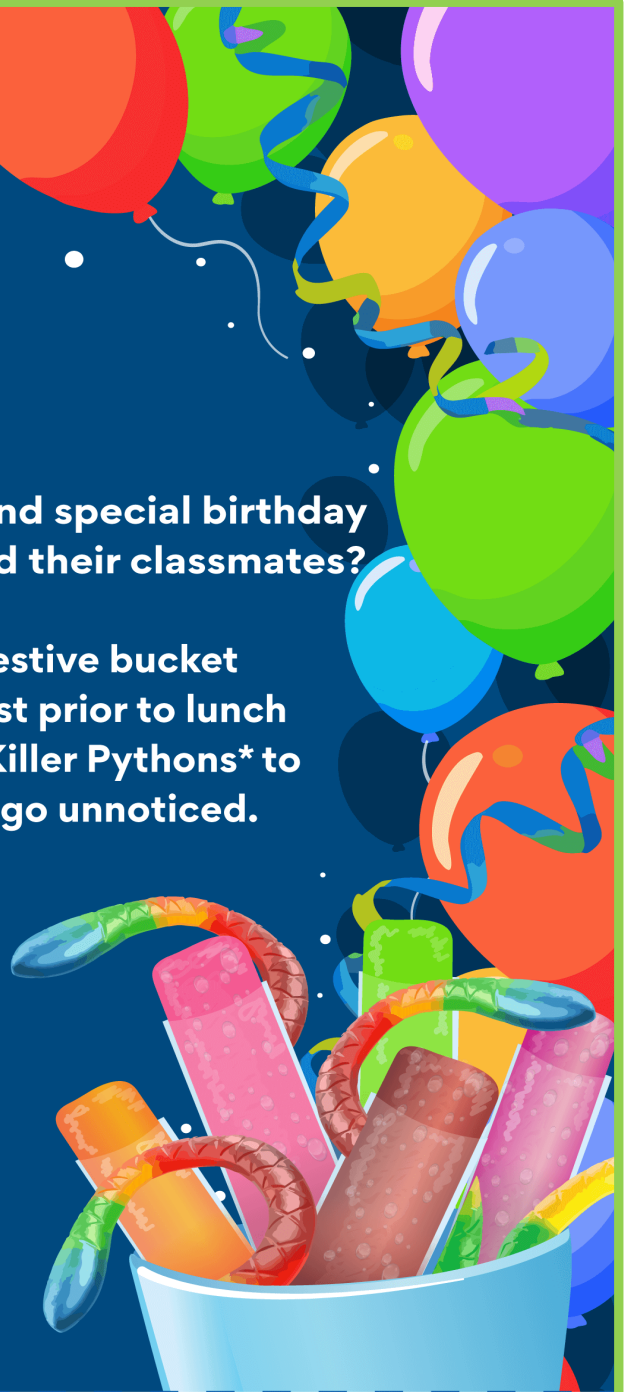
