Principal Team Report

The Ice Bucket Challenge

Grade 3-4 Camp 2025

Preparations for our Grade 3-4 Camp in 2025 are now well advanced with the camp due to be held from Monday 23rd to Wednesday 25th June. This year we head to Camp Manyung in Mount Eliza which is a long-time favourite at APPS and we have been many times before. Run by the YMCA, it offers an excellent camping experience for students and staff with activities including the Flying Fox, Tree Rolling, archery, orienteering and bush craft. The experience is designed to build independence in a highly supported environment and is lots of fun for all.

Student Achievement Reports and Parent/Carer Teacher interviews



Teachers have recently been working on the mid-year student achievement reports. As part of this process, students have been completing various assessment tasks, and it has been wonderful to celebrate the progress our students have made in their learning. The mid-year reports will be distributed to families on Tuesday 1st July, via Xuno.

An important part of Amsleigh Park's process in reporting achievement to parents and carers, is the Parent Teacher interviews. These interviews will be held at Amsleigh Park, on the afternoon and evening of Wednesday 2nd July and allow for further discussion and questions regarding your child's written report. It is a time to share successes and future goals regarding your child. We encourage all parents and carers to attend. Synthetic Phonics Mandated Across Victoria

In 2024 the Minister for Education, Ben Carroll, announced that all government schools in Victoria are mandated to undertake the teaching of synthetic phonics in Foundation to Grade 2. This direction was initiated due to the compelling evidence showing that this approach is highly effective in the teaching of reading and spelling. We are pleased to say that at Amsleigh Park we recognised this a long time ago and in fact started our journey with this around 2016, gradually adopting teaching practices in the teaching of phonics ever since then. Four years ago, we formally adopted 'Sounds Write' as our core approach and have made sure that all classroom teachers are trained as 'Sounds Write Practitioners.' To be an accredited practitioner a teacher needs to complete an intensive course (50+ hours) of training. All our new staff in 2025 have just completed their training and I would like to acknowledge and thank them for their commitment to this important learning. We have invested significant financial resources in this professional learning and in purchasing of decodable readers required to support this approach. As a result of both our foresight and investment, our students are already benefitting from this instructional approach, and we are well ahead of the curve. It's not often we 'toot' our own horns but I think that credit should be given where it's due. In this instance the credit goes to our teaching staff who have embraced this change and to Miss Barker who has led this work. Change takes a lot of time and effort, and we have been highly successful in the way we have approached this. We now take the mindset that 'when you know better, you do better,' and apply this same lens to all areas of our teaching.

Enrolments 2025

This term we have been super busy with running tours of Amsleigh Park for prospective parents. Interest in our school is very healthy, and we often get good feedback from visitors who like our caring and friendly environment. We are currently taking Foundation enrolments for 2026. If your child has a younger sibling due to start school in 2026, please see <https://students.educationapps.vic.gov.au/s/> to complete a digital enrolment application. Families need to submit their enrolments application before the end of Term 2. We look forward to getting to know our 2026 Foundation students through the Foundation transition program in Term 4.

What's Happening in our Buildings and Grounds

We have a wonderful school campus, generous in size and with outstanding learning spaces and playgrounds. Keeping it all in good order keeps us busy and in recent times we have achieved the following:

- New shade sails installed over the Grade 3-6 playground.
- The annual audit of our trees was completed, and work done to remove or prune any trees considered unsafe.
- Currently, a new kitchen is being installed in the 'Out of School Hours Care' building otherwise known as 'The Shack.' This upgrade brings this facility into line with the expectations of the Monash Council.
- Work is needed on some of the older parts of our sewer waste lines as some of this is 95+ years old and has been damaged by tree roots. We have temporarily closed our outside toilets so the sewer can continue to operate until works can be completed.
- Our adventure playgrounds have been audited to ensure they are in good working order.

Always lots to do in this area.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.

Parents are responsible to ensure up to date Action Plans and medications are provided to the school and must inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students. It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates

If you have any details that need to be updated – phone numbers, home address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details

It will then let you update any of your details and it will notify us of any changes that have been made. This is an instant update.

CSEF – Do you have a healthcare/pension card?

Parents - If you currently hold a Centrelink health care or pension card **and did not claim CSEF through our school last year**, please come and see the office team and we can help you to apply for the CSEF payment. This is a \$154 per child payment to financially assist families with the cost of Camps, Sports Excursions, Swimming etc.

Birthday Bucket Bookings / Payments

A reminder that all bookings for Birthday Buckets must be made with Admin Staff at the office, one week prior to your requested date. Payment by credit / debit card can be made in person at the office or over the phone.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS (SSB)

Families wishing to use their School Saving Bonus for camp, excursions/incursions, activities must take the following steps: -

1. Reallocate your School Saving Bonus from the default "Textbooks/Uniforms" in the School Saving Bonus portal to "School Activities" It is recommended that the whole \$400 is reallocated in one transaction by parents of students going to camp this year. This will decrease the number of processes required by parents and also Admin staff.
2. Select SSB / CSEF in the Xuno payment section of the event and then enter either the SSB Voucher Number when prompted or type "CSEF" as the voucher code if selecting CSEF as the payment option.

School Saving Bonus (SSB) Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Can I use the SSB to purchase stationary/book packs?**

No. The SSB cannot be used to purchase Book Packs/Book List Items. The Department of Education has included Textbooks only as allowable purchases using the SSB from authorised suppliers. Amsleigh Park PS students do not require any textbooks.

- **Do I need to allocate money to online uniforms in the SSB Portal?**

No, because we have a school run onsite uniform shop. Parents will only need to complete **a Green SSB uniform order form (check you have a Term 2 current form)** and submit it to the school office for all uniform items. Admin staff will process then forward the order to the uniform shop for picking and packing. Orders will be sent to the child's classroom unless an alternative collection point is requested.

- **Can I take uniforms on the day if I want to use the SSB?**

No. You will need to submit **a Green SSB uniform order form** to the office for processing by Admin Staff. Once processed, the order will be given to the Uniform Shop. Orders may take a week, or longer to be filled depending on processing times, submission day of the order form and stock availability.

- **Can I only use the SSB on uniform purchases before June 30, 2025?**

Yes. After June 30, 2025, the SSB money will automatically be allocated to school activities.

- **Will I need to put the voucher code into the portal to re-allocate the SSB from uniforms to activities?**

Yes – For parents with students who will be attending camp in 2025, please allocate the whole amount of the SSB (\$400) in one transaction to "School Activities"

- **Can I pay for events/activities in Xuno with SSB for activities**

Yes. Each time you wish to use the SSB for payment of a school activity, you will need to select the SSB payment option in Xuno and enter the voucher code.

- **Does the SSB money expire if I don't use it all in 2025?**

No. The money will carry over to the following year

- **Is the SSB only able to be used for each individual sibling?**

No. The SSB is allocated to the family and can be used for any student in the immediate family

Incorrect payment methods made by parents, eg, Credit card instead of School Savings Bonus and vice versa cannot be refunded/re-processed.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and advise us of any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year **unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.**

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

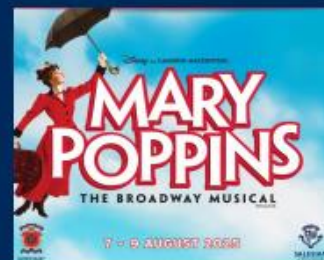
