Principal Team Report

Welcome Back for Term 3

A warm welcome back to all members of the Amsleigh Park Primary School community for Term 3. I hope that everyone enjoyed a great break away from the rigours of school life. There were some nice sunny days, and I hope our students got out in the fresh air. Personally, I made good use of the sunshine and got out on the bike as often as I could.

In Term 3 I always talk about it as the 'hardworking term.' It's a term of consolidation in which our students can make increased gains in their learning and use the improvement areas from their mid-year report to set challenging learning goals. Our students should start to accelerate in their learning by focusing their efforts every day at school. Parents and carers can support this endeavour by checking in with their child/ren as the term progresses and reinforcing the need to do their best every day and persevere when challenged.

Mid-Year Reports

Student Reports were distributed in Term 2, and I ask you to join with us in celebrating the many wonderful achievements made by our students. Miss Carr and I enjoyed reading the wonderful general comments from class teachers, and we appreciate how personalised our reports are. It is important to celebrate each child's progress at school, which helps to build their self-esteem and learning confidence. Students work very hard at school, and it can be tiring to focus on learning for many hours every day. I commend our students on their efforts and congratulate them warmly on the great progress they are making. Of course, there is still work to be done and progress to be made, so I encourage our students to keep up their efforts.



Foundation Enrolments for 2026

The deadline for all Foundation Enrolment Applications for 2026 is Friday 25th July. All applications should be made using the Vic Students portal. If any families need assistance, please contact the general office. It's looking very positive so far and we will know shortly on the number of Foundation students for 2026.

Breakfast Club

The Victorian Government and Department of Education has committed to giving all schools the opportunity to participate in the 'Breakfast Club' program. This program has a range of different scenarios to provide students with nutritious food at school. Sadly, there are students across Victoria who come to school every day without having had a good breakfast. At Amsleigh Park, we would like to get this program off the ground, but we need some assistance. Whilst the food is all provided, we will need parent/carer volunteers to run this program, and we will need one person to take on the role of coordinator. The current proposal would be to run a breakfast club once per week from 8.15am – 8.45am in which students come along and enjoy a healthy breakfast. The coordinator would be responsible for ordering the food via the special portal, which is then delivered directly to the school. They would also organise a roster of parents and carers to come along and assist. The foods on offer would include cereal, toast and fruit. NAPLAN 2025

The results of NAPLAN testing for 2025 came out this week and we are pleased to see that our students in Grades 3 & 5 were successful. Two standout areas are reading and writing. Given we have put a lot of effort into the structured literacy over the past few years this result is very pleasing for our staff and students.

The proficiency standards for NAPLAN are as follows:

- **Exceeding:** the student's result exceeds expectations at the time of testing.
- **Strong:** the student's result meets challenging but reasonable expectations at the time of testing.
- **Developing:** the student's result indicates that they are working towards expectations at the time of testing.
- **Needs additional support:** the student's result indicates that they are not achieving the learning outcomes expected at the time of testing. They are likely to need additional support to progress satisfactorily. It will be the clear responsibility of schools to ensure these students are provided with the additional support needed to progress satisfactorily, informed by NAPLAN results, other school-based assessment data and teachers' knowledge of these students.

Students' NAPLAN reports will continue to show how they are tracking in comparison to their peers and provide an indication of their skill levels against national averages and where we would expect them to be to get the most out of schooling. This provides valuable information to teachers about how we can continue to support your child.

Each set of NAPLAN results is an important milestone but it's also important that students know that one result does not define them – these results are about making sure every student gets the support they need so they can continue to get the best from their learning. Copies of student NAPLAN results will be sent home to parents this week. Please retain this report for future reference as the school does not have copies on file.

The school production 2025

There is a lot to look forward to across Term 3 with our annual School Production high on our list of exciting learning opportunities. The production for 2025, 'A Test of Time' will be performed on Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th August at Salesian College. All classes will once again participate in the production through a dancing/singing performance. Costumes, lights and a vibrant soundtrack will also be part of the fun. As in past years we run a very tight production schedule so that this event does not interfere with other learning programs.



Gifts for Staff

The Department of Education periodically remind us about the rules around accepting gifts from parents and carers. Whilst we would always say that your 'thanks' is enough, I know that some families like to acknowledge the teacher or education support staff through a small gift. It is perfectly OK for staff to accept these gifts, but they must be less than \$100 in value. Occasionally parents and carers will contribute to a group gift, and this is also OK so long as the individual amounts contributed don't exceed \$100 in value. Of course, there is no obligation to provide a gift to staff but for those who do it's better that we all know the rules for this kind of thing.

Team Kids

We heard some great feedback about the school holiday program for Term 2 which was great news. There were numerous fun activities and excursions on offer. Most days the program was almost fully subscribed. We have also now completed a refurbishment of the kitchen in the 'Shack' and it's a great improvement to this facility. The TK staff are super happy with their new kitchen and have been cooking up a storm.

School Facilities

I'm relieved to report that our sewer has been repaired during the school holidays so the toilets in our main building are now working again. It's a beautiful old building but the pipes in the ground are older earthen ware and once the tree roots get into them it's hard to fix. Over the longer term we will need to get them replaced, which will require substantial works, and we are planning for that so the problem will be fixed up permanently.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.

Parents are responsible to ensure up to date Action Plans and medications are provided to the school and must inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be stored securely at the office for the safety of all students. It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates

If you have any details that need to be updated – phone numbers, home address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details

It will then let you update any of your details and notify us of any changes that have been made. Admin Staff will then update the school's data base which in turn flows through to Xuno.

A reminder that all bookings for Birthday Buckets must be made with Admin Staff at the office, one week prior to your requested date. Payment by credit / debit card can be made in person at the office or over the phone.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and advise us of any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.
