School Breakfast Program

As previously communicated, we are currently working on starting a breakfast club program at Amsleigh Park. We are fortunate to have two parents interested in helping with organisation and coordination. The current aim is to run a breakfast club for children on Tuesday mornings before school. We will also be looking for some parents or carers who might be interested in helping either regularly or casually. Look out for an email about this which will have a link to a form in which to express interest. All helpers need a **volunteer working with children check**, which is FREE and easy to organise. Running this breakfast club will offer yet another opportunity to support students to experience a positive school life.

Our Great Uniform Shop

During 2025 Lemo Spindzos has been doing a wonderful job looking after the Amsleigh Park PS uniform shop and I want to say thanks from us all. Having a volunteer run our uniform shop also means that we can keep it

as a non-profit entity and our uniforms are sold at the wholesale price that we pay for them. This is a big saving for all families and otherwise they would more expensive. Having a shop onsite is convenient and there are not many schools who can maintain this kind of service. A big shout out to Lemo and the helpers who pitch in to make this work.



Mobile Phones Under 13

Last week a story was doing the rounds in the media about a recent study into the use of mobile phones by children under the age of 13. The study, published in the Journal for Human Development and Capabilities, discusses the global rise in smartphone and social media use and how it has dramatically reshaped childhood and adolescence. It looks at the effects of smartphone ownership before the age of 13 on mental health and wellbeing. The results showed that the relationship between earlier smartphone ownership and poor mental health outcomes in early adulthood, particularly among females, especially when paired with access to algorithmically curated social media (which is pretty much all social media), profoundly diminishes mind health and wellbeing and is associated with increased symptoms and diminished functioning across a range of domains, with consequences extending into education and civic participation.

Accessing social media and smartphones is often an unsupervised gateway that disrupts key developmental activities such as person-to-person relationships and sleep. It also exposes children to harmful content online including violence, ideologies, deepfakes and inappropriate images.

As the age at which children receive a smartphone continues to decrease, the "data suggests a concerning trajectory toward a population with higher rates of aggression, suicidal thoughts, feelings of detachment from reality, and diminished self-worth, emotional control, and resilience."

The study found that, "globally, the age of access to social media accounts for approximately 40% of the overall association between age of smartphone ownership and mind health. Other significant contributing factors include poor family relationships (13%), cyberbullying (10%), and disrupted sleep (12%). Notably, 68% of the negative impacts associated with poor family relationships and 63% of the negative impacts associated with cyberbullying are downstream of age of first social media account."

The authors of the study call for restrictions on the use of smartphones and social media, similarly to what we see with tobacco, alcohol and driving, based on a child's developing mind and body during these critical

formative years. This is of course what Australia will be introducing later in the year with a world first ban on social media by the Federal government.

Connecting with other people is the essence of humanity. School is one of the best places to achieve that, but so too is joining a club and actively engaging in in-person social activities outside of school hours. I would encourage all families to investigate the study and make an informed choice regarding smartphone access for primary school aged children.

One option that all parents have right now is to empower themselves when it comes to their child's use of technology. Setting boundaries and limits early can have many positive benefits over the long term.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor. Parents are responsible to ensure up to date Action Plans and medications are provided to the school and must inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan. All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, <u>must be signed in by a parent and stored securely at the office</u> for the safety of all students.

It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates

If you have any details that need to be updated – phone numbers, home address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details
It will then let you update any of your details and notify us of any changes that have been made. Admin Staff will then update the school's data base which in turn flows through to Xuno.

A reminder that all bookings for Birthday Buckets must be made with <u>Admin Staff at the office</u>, one week prior to your requested date. Payment by credit / debit card can be made in person at the office or over the phone.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family" for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.


