Whole School Transition -2026



We are currently in our long-range planning phase for the 2026 school year. Thanks to those families who have completed the enrolment census. We're keen to hear from any families planning on making a change next year, as we're making planning decisions based on anticipated student numbers.

Another part of our planning, is supporting students with year-toyear transition. As our students progress from one year level to the next, it is important that they feel prepared for what lays ahead.

Our Whole School Transition Program supports our students with their level-to-level transition, through multiple sessions in December. During these visits, students go as a cohort to spend time in the next year level's learning spaces, with the current teachers of those levels. Here the students get to know other teachers and the key differences between their current year level and the one ahead. Students have a chance to ask questions and get to know students they may not have been in a class with before. The program culminates with our Smart Start session on Wednesday 17th December, where students will meet with their 2026 grades and teachers where possible. The program begins with our first session on Tuesday 2nd December. Thanks to Miss Liana Kirton for coordinating this whole school program.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor. Parents are responsible to ensure up to date Action Plans and medications are provided to the school and must inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan. All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, <u>must be signed in by a parent and stored securely at the office</u> for the safety of all students.

It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates

If you have any details that need to be updated – phone numbers, home address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details
It will then let you update any of your details and notify us of any changes that have been made. Admin Staff will then update the school's data base which in turn flows through to Xuno.

Birthday Bucket Bookings / Payments

A reminder that all bookings for Birthday Buckets must be made with <u>Admin Staff at the office</u>, one week prior to your requested date. Please do not contact PFA members directly to make bookings as the Booking Diary is kept at the General Office. Payment by credit / debit card only can be made in person at the office or over the phone.

- 4. Order will be processed and uniform items and will be either sent home with your child or collected from the office if requested. Orders are usually completed within one week (excepting unavoidable delays from the supplier). Any items not available at time of order will be placed on back order and provided as soon as possible.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family" for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and advise us of any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

- Meet their Grade 6 Buddies



Here's what you need to know to place your order.

New and Returning Users

Already Registered? If you ordered school Book List supplies last year with Office Corporate, you don't need to create a new account. Simply go to www.booklistorders.com.au and reset your password.

New Users? First, go to www.booklistorders.com.au to register. Make sure to use the school code AMS26 when creating your account.



When you create your password, it must be at least 12 characters long and include:

- An uppercase letter (A-Z)
- A lowercase letter (a-z)
- A number (0-9)
- A special character (!@#\$%^&*)

For example: Booklist123!

Once you've set your password, check your email for a verification link. Click the link to activate your account and view pricing.



How to Place Your Order

- Log in to your account. Select your child's year level (Prep/Foundation to Year 6).
- 2. View Book Pack Details. The ordering page shows exactly what's included in each year level pack. All of the items & quantities have been requested by the year level teachers and are pre-loaded. You can modify quantities of any item in the Essential Category, items listed as Required, are fixed to the cart, and cannot be changed. Items listed as Optional can be retained from the previous year if still in good condition or purchased again if required.

Please note, that if you do reduce the recommended quantities, a \$5.50 individual packing fee will be incurred. Alternatively, if you add the full list to cart, the \$5.50 fee will be automatically discounted at checkout.

Add Your Student's Name. Please make sure to add your student's name on the ordering page. If
you have multiple children, add each student's name and their book pack separately. This helps
the school track which families have placed orders.
