Performance Assembly Next Week

So far this year we have all enjoyed some wonderful performances at Monday assembly and next Monday 22nd June we have another one lined up. We can look forward to a performance by our very own Leigh Club Choir. If you are here on Monday morning you are welcome to drop in and enjoy the performance.

Morning Routines

From 8.52am every morning students come into class to prepare for the school day, and teachers assume duty of care for their classes. As you know the 8.52am routine has been in focus lately as we are working on some improvements so that all our students can start the school day feeling calm and ready to learn.

We would like to remind everyone that from 8.52am our teachers need to be focused on students and support them to get ready for the day. We hope you will understand that this means they are generally not able to talk to parents or carers other than to take onboard a quick message.

We do want to be accessible, but it needs to be balanced out with the teacher's duty of care to their students. If you need to talk to the teacher about a concern this is important, this is best done at a time when the teacher can give you their full attention. If the concern is urgent, you could also come and talk to Miss Carr or Mr Cormick, and we will normally be able to assist as an initial step.

Our student Leaders

I want to highlight the great job our Student Leaders are doing in 2026. It's an important opportunity to develop their leadership skills and act as a role model for other students. Our leaders are also responsible for several daily tasks, such as the bike sheds and recycling, undertaking these tasks with diligence and commitment. Well done and congratulations to our Grade 6 Student Leadership team, keep up the good work!



Foundation Enrolments for 2027

It's been a very busy term for tours of prospective parents happening every week at Amsleigh Park Primary School. This is important work for the leadership team as we want to keep our school enrolment stable around the mid-300s. We don't want to grow an empire but having about 350 students is a sweet spot for our school and it means we have the resources we need to manage our school.

Often 'word of mouth' is an important factor in school promotion, and we appreciate that we have lots of parents and carers putting in a positive word for us. This year I have heard this a lot from parents touring our school. Enrolment for Foundation closes at the end of July so if anyone has not enrolled a younger brother or sister yet we encourage you to get onto it as soon as possible. The general office can be contacted if you need assistance.

Student Supervision After School

We have had some recent reports about some rough play in the school yard after school, and we want to ensure there is clarity for everyone about supervision of children at this time of the day.

The teacher on after school yard duty is there to ensure all students are picked up from school safely and keep a general eye on the yard. They will intervene if they have any reports of concerning behaviour or other safety matters until 3.45pm. An announcement is made after 3.45pm for any students who have not been picked up to come to the office.

It is OK for families to hang around after school and enjoy catching up with friends and for children to enjoy our wonderful playgrounds. We encourage this but it is important to note that once a parent and/or responsible adult has arrived children are under their direct supervision. This includes knowing where children are in the yard and what they are doing. If everyone can please note this and just keep an eye out, we should be able to minimise any unsafe play or disagreements between students.

Whole School Production- Term 3

We ask all families to please put Tuesday 18th and Wednesday 19th August in their calendars for our whole school production next term. We look forward to putting on two fun nights of entertainment for our community and a rich learning experience for our students.

We have an exciting new venue for our school production this year, Crossways Church Theatre, in Burwood East. Other primary schools in our area have used this venue for their primary school shows with great success. While this venue is a little further from Amsleigh Park, the benefits include:

- * Tiered, well-spaced seating where all audience members will have a clearer view of the stage
- * An accessible venue, including access, toilets, parking etc...
- * a carpark large enough to accommodate all audience vehicles making traffic management safer
- * a large, heated foyer with tables and chairs, where audience members can wait before the show, inside out of the weather, or wait on an evening they are not watching
- * And for students, auditorium seating to watch the show from.

Keep an eye out for details coming home soon about parent/carer helpers, ticketing, costumes etc.

Early Arrivals at school

Most families should and do arrive sometime after 8.30am and whilst this is not an official time there should be no students in our yard before this time at a minimum. We ask for your support in planning for your child if they need to come to school early. Before school care at Team Kids is available every day from 7.00am.

With holidays next week our students have a chance to recharge and enjoy and change of pace. It might be colder outside right now, but this is no reason for children not to get out in the fresh air. The trick is to get children rugged up and embrace the fresh air. Winter sunshine can also be quite pleasant and have a wonderful rejuvenating effect. Spending time out in the fresh air is invigorating and encourages children to be physically active. Current thinking is that at a minimum, children need to be active for 15 minutes about 4 times each day to build their fitness and wellbeing. The school holidays present an ideal time to get out and about, hope you make the most of it.

Student Medications

A reminder that a Medical Action Plan, completed by a doctor, must be provided for any student medication (e.g. Ventolin, Epi Pens, severe allergy medication) stored at the school office.

We cannot store or administer any medication without an Action Plan containing instructions from a doctor.

Parents are responsible to ensure up to date Action Plans and medications are provided to the school and must inform the school office of any changes to a student's medical condition / action plan.

All other medication must have a medication authority form completed by a parent at the Office.

All medication, including over the counter types, must be signed in by a parent and stored securely at the General Office for the safety of all students.

It is recommended that students with hay fever etc. take their medication at home before school.

Absences/ Late Arrivals

A reminder that all absences should be reported via Xuno, including any family holidays.

Parents are responsible for addressing and updating their child's 'Unexplained Absences' in Xuno.

Students arriving late to school must be first signed in at the office by a parent before going to class.

School Emails - Check the email you are replying to

When contacting classroom teachers or responding to their emails via Xuno, remember to double check the 'To' address.

Many emails meant for classroom teachers are arriving in the Amsleigh Park PS inbox, along with a huge number of other daily external emails.

Replying to the school inbox may delay your communication being received by the classroom teacher in a timely manner and creates extra work for Admin staff.

Change of Details Updates - Xuno

If you have any family details that need to be updated – phone numbers, home address, emergency contacts, work details, etc this can all be done via Xuno.

You need to click Full Xuno > School > Students > Contact Details > Update details

You can then update any of your details. We receive a notification of the changes that have been made. Admin Staff will then update the school's data base, which in turn flows back through to Xuno.

Birthday Bucket Bookings / Payments

A reminder that all bookings for Birthday Buckets must be made with Admin Staff at the office, one week prior to your requested date. Please do not contact PFA members directly to make bookings as the Booking Diary is kept at the General Office. Payment by credit / debit card only can be made in person at the office or over the phone.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF) 2026

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF.

A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families.

The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$400 for primary school students
- \$400 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form. A copy of your eligible Centrelink concession or pension card is required.

If you applied for CSEF at our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments:** your child has started or changed schools this year.
- **changed family circumstances:** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Amsleigh Park uses Xuno as our main communication tool with families, including newsletter distribution, absence notifications, student reports, communication with your child's teacher, messages and reminders, event approvals and online payments.

Xuno is a web-based school management program that has a website portal for use in a browser and an App, 'Xuno Family' for use on smart phones or tablets.

It is easy to use and is a vital tool to keep our parents informed about their child/ren's school life and all things happening at Amsleigh Park.

Bookings for "Get to Know You" & Parent Teacher interviews are also managed through Xuno.

Parents can use Xuno to notify the school of any address/contact detail changes, absences, late arrivals, upcoming family holidays etc.

For new families - On enrolment, you should have received a welcome email from Xuno (please check your junk folder if not received in your inbox), with information on how to create your Xuno account. Please follow the instructions and links in the email to create a Xuno account and password.

As Xuno is our main communication tool, it is important that all families are signed up so they are aware of school information and events and can easily inform the school of their child's absences and advise us of any changes to family or emergency contact details.

Please contact the office if you require a Xuno welcome email to be resent or a password reset.

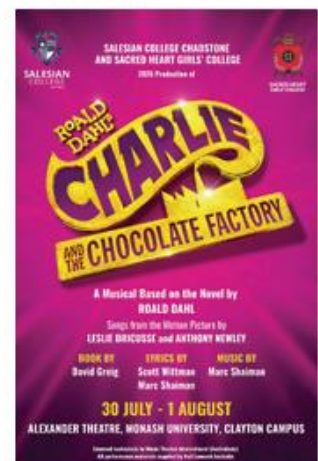
